According to the Colorado checkoff statute (CRS 35-57.5-101-119), the seller is responsible for paying the assessment either by direct payment in private treaty sales or by having the payment deducted from their sale proceeds through an auction market or to feeders or slaughter facilities. These reports are to be submitted by the seller in private treaty sales along with the appropriate assessment. Reports are to be submitted when any of the following criteria is met:

- 1) \$20 in assessments is reached*
- 2) At the end of the sale season (after club lambs are sold, bucks are sold, etc) or*
- 3) At the end of the current calendar year. All assessments for the calendar year should be submitted by December 15th.*
